

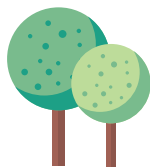
Road Map to Success

Stay on track to get your New York license



▶ You're 16!

- ▶ Apply for your learner's permit.
- ▶ Make an appointment for a written test and vision test at a DMV office.

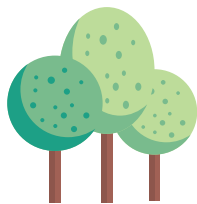
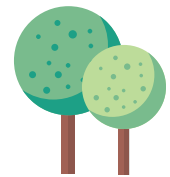


- ▶ Once you receive your learner's permit, proceed to your Driver Education Classroom course.
- ▶ Enroll in the **5-hour Pre-Licensing** course with AAA Driver Training School (or take driver's education at your high school).



- ▶ Begin the required **50 hours** of supervised driving with a parent or guardian. You must:

- ▶ Drive at least **15 hours** at night
- ▶ Drive at least **10 hours** in moderate or heavy traffic



- ▶ AAA offers in-car lessons with a professional driving instructor, which count toward the supervised driving requirement.



- ▶ **You're in the home stretch!** Once you have your permit for 6 months and have completed your required hours, schedule your **road test** at a DMV office.

- ▶ Make sure to bring all your required documents.
