Stay on track to get your Connecticut license

▶ You're 16!

Study the online driver's manual and make an appointment for your Learner's Permit test.

2

▶ Once you have your permit, begin on-road practice with a parent or professional driving instructor.

3

- ▶ Enroll in the **required 8-hour Safe Driving Practices** course with AAA Driving Training. Mandatory 2-hour parent class included.
- ▶ Complete **22 hours** of classroom study at home.

4

- ▶ **You're in the home stretch!** Complete at least 40 hours of driving practice. AAA offers in-car lessons that count toward this requirement!
- ▶ After **6 months** with your learner's permit, you're ready for your **road test**.

5

- ▶ Schedule your appointment with a local DMV office. Make sure you have all the required materials.

- ▶ Check your vehicle's systems, lights and tires; your vehicle will be inspected before the road test.
