▶ You're 16!

It's time to enroll in a Driver Education course.

2

▶ Once you enroll in driver's ed, you will make an appointment with the driving school and MVC to take your vision test and knowledge exam at the MVC.

▶ Be sure to bring all your required documents with you to the appointment at the MVC.

▶ Proceed to scheduling your 6 hours of professional instruction with AAA Driver Training.

▶ Advance to practicing your driving skills with at least **6 months of supervised driving** with a parent or guardian.

▶ You are only permitted to drive between the hours of 5 a.m. – 11 p.m.

▶ **You're 17!** Schedule your **road test** at a licensing center.

6

Congratulations! You're now officially a licensed New Jersey driver with a probationary license, good for one year!*
